	The Profit and Loss statement explains our operational, <i>member</i> revenue for the year and our operational <i>member</i> expenses for the year and reports	
	only those items.	
	[Sponsorship transactions do not impact the Profit and Loss account in any way.]	
	The Balance sheet documents our <i>member</i> assets such as our operating bank account, apparel, equipment and Just Cars truck. It also lists our	
	sponsor bank account which is a separate account representing funds we	
	hold in trust on behalf of the competitors and the same figure is shown as a	
	liability as we "owe" those funds to the competitors. When expenses and	
	competitor distributions are paid, the bank account and corresponding	
	liability reduce by the same amount - balance sheet impact only.	
	The effect of having 40 few members than this time last year has meant a	
	revenue shortfall of about \$4,000 yet quite a few of our expenses are fixed which impacts our profitability. The committee have been conscious of this	
	and you'll see membership expenses are well down in 2025 as we subsidised	
	fewer activities. Similarly, our trophy expenditure was less in 2025. In 2023	
	and 2024 we produced June and December magazines but we shall not be	
	producing a June 2025 magazine as we continue to exercise fiscal restraint.	
	As at 31 May 2025 we have \$31,375.34 in our operational, member account	
	(31 May 2024 \$32,723.44) and \$10,214 in our <u>sponsor</u> bank account (31	
	May 2024 \$12,703.25)	
	Our financial position is sound but is being carefully monitored in these	
	difficult economic times.
